

# Suggested SAT & Subject Testing Calendar

Students should plan to take the SAT test two or three times.

Subject Tests should be taken upon completion of related courses, usually in June.

**Sophomore Year:** No testing is required this year. Many students choose to practice for the SAT and take subject tests if they are taking that subject this year.

October	PSAT ( <i>for practice</i> )
June	Subject Tests ( <i>if applicable and completing a course in the subject</i> )

**Junior Year:** Students should take all tests at least once by the end of their junior year

October	PSAT ( <i>for practice</i> )
March and/or May	SAT SAT or Subject Tests
June	SAT or Subject Tests

*Note: Summer break is a good time to practice for improvement if planning to retake a test in the fall.*

**Senior Year:** many students choose to retake their SAT and Subjects, these dates are available.

October	Retake SAT or Subject Tests ( <i>as needed</i> )
November	Retake SAT or Subject Tests ( <i>as needed</i> )
December	Retake SAT or Subject Tests ( <i>as needed</i> )

*Note: Early decision applications are often due November 1<sup>st</sup>. All testing needs to be reported with the application so plan testing accordingly.*

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## Suggested ACT Testing Calendar

Recently many students have decided to try the ACT exam in lieu of the SAT. You do NOT need both an SAT and ACT test score for college admissions. Check the test content to make a decision about which to take.

<b>Junior Year:</b>	April or June	ACT (+ writing for UC's)
<b>Senior Year:</b>	September or October	Retake ACT (+ writing)

*Note: Subject tests are required along with an ACT score for UC schools.*
