Yes, every Wednesday, “A” period starts at 7:45am and first period starts at 8:35am.

First contact the teacher, second the counselor, and third the appropriate Associate Principal.

Yes, because after a number of tardies, your child will be referred to detention or Saturday School (be early because being on time is to be late and being late is unacceptable). After 3 cuts your child will be referred to SARB (Student Attendance Review Board).

All visitors, which is defined as someone who is not a student or campus personnel, are required to sign in at the Main Office before they enter the campus.
