- OR -

2. Use the 11 x 17 paper that is provided for you in the labeled bin in the LL Attendance Office to use with personal printed pictures.

For either option [1 or 2] YOU will need to get your board laminated. OfficeMax on North Main laminates for \$4.35 for these sizes. 2520 N Main Street Walnut Creek CA 94597

You are welcome to use any photo service that you like (Shutterfly, mPix, etc). Just be sure to use the same guidelines and check timelines for delivery.

For your reference, here is an example – use your creativity to show off your senior, but <u>please use these quidelines</u>:

- Size must be no larger than 12 x 18 (can by 11 x14, 11 x 17) to be able to accommodate all students' boards
- Create in landscape (horizontal) direction
- All pictures and words need to be appropriate (G-Rated)
- Single hole-punch in upper left and right corners
- Write your student's name on the back of the board
- Get Board Laminated
- After the graduation ceremony, please take your student's board home with you!




Complete and return to the collection box in the Attendance Office by 4/26 to be displayed at Senior Picnic on 4/30. Late submissions will be displayed at other events!
